In compliance with the University Grants Commission circular D.O. No. F. 1-74/2016 (ACR) dated 8th July 2024 Jamia Hamdard observed the "The anti-ragging week" from 12th August to 18th August 2024 by organizing a series of events at the university. The following events were organised during the Anti Ragging week

Day 1st (12th August 2024): Inaugural Session & Orientation

Street Play

Day 2nd (13th August 2024): Poster making competition

- Day 3rd (14th August 2024): Slogan writing competition
- Day 4th (16th August 2024): Documentary screening of film on anti-ragging awareness.

Day 1st The inaugural programme of anti ragging week started on the 12th of August 2024 at 10:00 a.m. Shri Ajay Chaudhary (Special Commissioner of Police, Traffic Management Division) was invited as the Chief Guest and Prof. Sudhir Kumar (Chief Proctor of Jawaharlal

Nehru University) was invited as the Guest of Honour. The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Jamia Hamdard, Prof. (Dr) Afshar Alam presided over the event.

The event started with the blessings of the Almighty. Mr. Abdul Farooqui, Imam Saheb, Rabia Masjid recited a verse from the Holy Quran followed by the Hamdard Tarana by the students of Jamia Hamdard. The welcome address was delivered by the Chief Proctor, Jamia Hamdard, Prof M. Sarwar Alam. This was followed by felicitation of the guests and a planter presentation to them as a token of gratitude. The event then proceeded with speeches by DSW Prof Reshma Nasreen and Registrar, Dr M. A Sikandar. They talked about the impact of ragging on students' mental health and made them aware of the consequences. The students were encouraged to report incidents of ragging without fear of retaliation. Prof. Sudhir Kumar, ChiefProctor, JNU sensitised the students and spoke about the detrimental effects of ragging and the legal consequences. The chief guest, Shri. Ajay Chaudhary, addressed the audience with his inspiring speech and sensitized the students by sharing some personal anecdotes. Hon'ble ViceChancellor delivered the Presidential address and expressed the legal definition of ragging andurged to unite against ragging. He reinforced the commitment of the university to its zero- tolerance policy on ragging.

After the presidential address, the chief guest and the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor administered Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyan (NMBA) mass pledge to the students and the staff both in Hindi and English. Dr. Nishat Quddus, Deputy Proctor delivered the vote of thanks and the event concluded with national Anthem.

A **Street Play** was performed on the theme "Ragging" by the students of Jamia Hamdard. 13 students were part of the street play and 25 student volunteers coordinated the event that took place throughout the week.

On Day 2nd (13th August 2024) & Day 3rd (14th August 2024), Jamia Hamdard hosted a Poster-Making and slogan-writing competition, attracting participation from 37 students across various schools within the university.
