





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

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

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



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

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

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

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

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

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



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

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

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Key observations and expectations of students:

- 1. Students requested for more information regarding career options
- 2. The overall processes regarding admission, result declaration should be much in time.
- 3. Students requested for clean washrooms.
- 4. They also desired talks on personal hygiene.
- 5. Students have requested that during online classes lectures could be recorded by the teachers in case some students missed the online class so that it could be provided to them.
- 6. More emphasis is required on skill based learning and promoting entrepreneurial skills in the students.
- 7. More programs sports and cultural events should be organized to refresh the mood of students.
- 8. Fees is on higher side. Some kind of concession in fees should be given to the needy students.
- 9. Students should be motivated to represent their research work on big platforms.
- 10. The first and the most important improvement should be of hostels because many students are from out of Delhi. Hostel should he provided to all students even in the first year.
- 11. Scholarships are not reachable to the needy students.
- 12. Companies should come to provide job as they are studying in number one of the top institutions in India.
- 13. There should be a rule that after passing the academic session, student can get their degrees at least within 6-8 months. No additional fee should be charged for obtaining degree.

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
