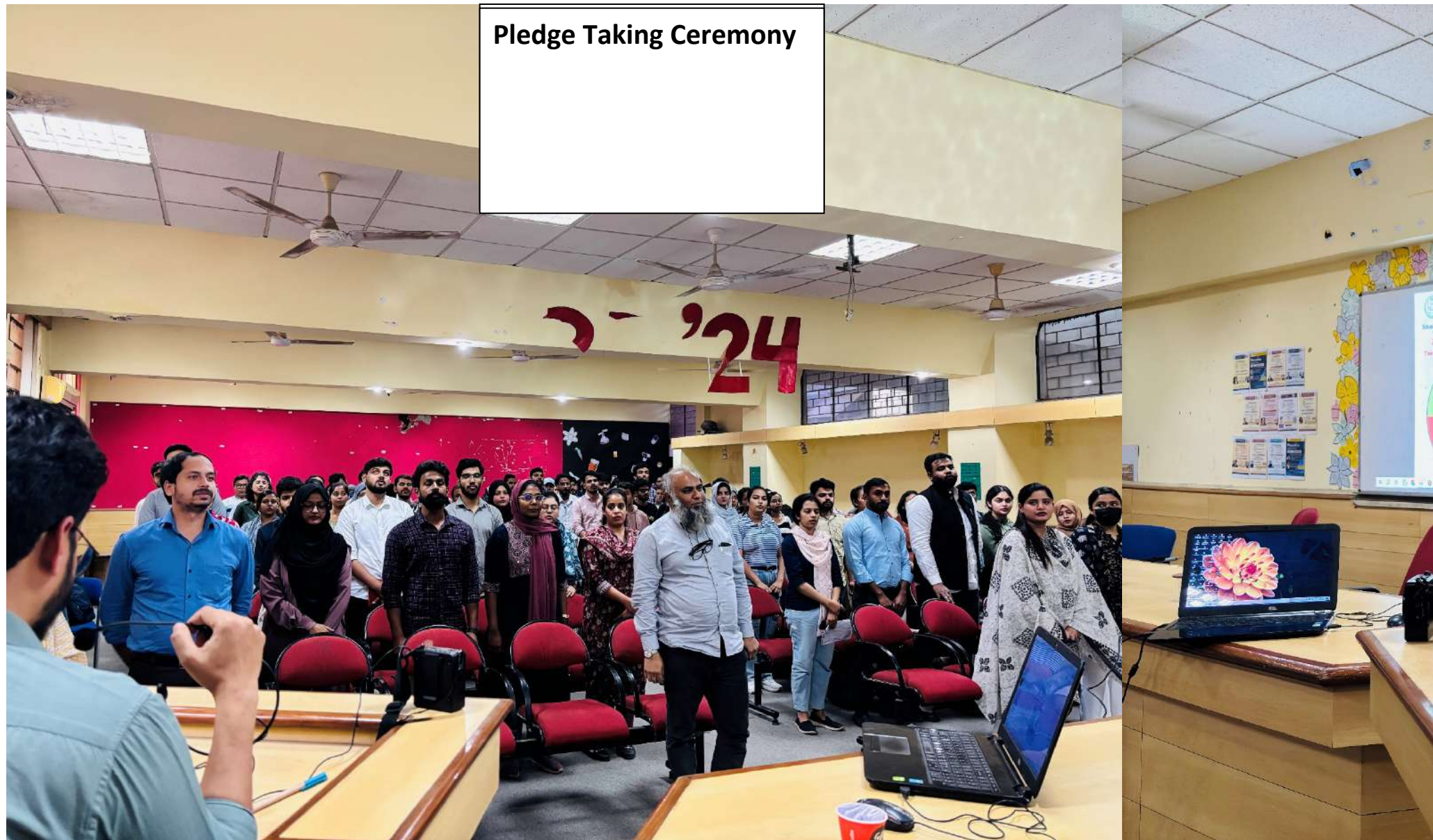
**PLEDGE FOR STUDENTS**
